Scholarship: A merit-based money gift given based on academics, athletics, musical skill, or other achievements.

Grant: A sum of money given to a student based on financial need.

Loan: A sum of money given to a student to be paid back with interest.

Work Study: A federal program that gives money upfront to students and is paid off through the semester.

STEP 1

More FAFSA Info

When applying for the 2022-2023 FAFSA, you will need your 2020 1040 Tax Return.

If you are completing the FAFSA before you complete your taxes, then provide your most recent information now and update the information later.

Use our Federal School Code (001220) to send the results to The Master's University (name appears as The Master's College during time of transition).

Start your FAFSA as early as October 1.
