- Satisfy all General Education requirements.
- Complete the required curriculum for the chosen major's field(s) of study.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.00 (cumulative) in all TMU Courses. *Some majors have different GPA requirements.*
- Complete a minimum of 32 semester units at TMU, not including Directed Studies coursework.
- A maximum of 12 units can be transferred to complete degree requirements after the last 12 units taken at TMU.
