

OFF-CAMPUS ASSISTANT

The Off-Campus Assistant (OCA) is a volunteer Residence Life position serving directly under the Off-Campus Director and the Deans. Off-Campus Assistants are chosen each year to serve the commuter population at TMU by facilitating community and service among themselves and connecting them to the larger student body on campus.

How do I know if being an OCA is right for me?

An OCA should be characterized by an **evident pursuit of Christlikeness** in both word and deed, a **pattern of humility, faithfulness, and teachability**, a growing expression of **selfless service**, an **eagerness to lead**, and a blend of **creativity**, **flexibility**, **and initiative** in programs and relationships.

What are the OCA's responsibilities?

- Cultivate unity among the commuters through envisioning and organizing commuter events and facilitating service opportunities
- Connect commuters to the campus community through frequent communication of announcements for on and off-campus events and activities (i.e. newsletter, email blast, sign posting, text messaging, etc.) and by acting as a liaison between Residence Life and the commuter student population
- Initiate opportunities with commuter students that would facilitate relationships characterized by mutual encouragement and care for one another
- Participate in the weekly gender-specific TMU Off-Campus Small Group, helping to co-lead under your respective Off-Campus Director
- Assist in commuter-related administrative tasks and oversight of the Off-Campus Lounge
- Meet biweekly with your Off-Campus Director for encouragement and leadership/personal development; meet regularly with your dorm team
- Attend August training retreats and Week of Welcome (WOW)
- Attend all training meetings September through April
- Complete summer preparation assignments

How many hours will this commitment involve?

• The OCA position is an average of 5 hours per week.

Is this a paid position?

• No, this is a volunteer position.
